What are my options for SPANISH progression?

Option #1



In this progression, Exploratory Spanish is intended to be part of an exploratory wheel and does not cover the high school Spanish I curriculum. The other three courses do collectively cover the Spanish I curriculum. These courses can be semester or year-long.

Option #2



In this progression, Exploratory Spanish is intended to be part of an exploratory wheel and does not cover the high school Spanish I curriculum. The other two courses do collectively cover the Spanish I curriculum. These courses must be yearlong courses.

11412Y0	Spanish I (MS for HS credit)	For the last class in either of the Spanish I series (three semesters or four semesters). 1 Credit
11412Y0V	Spanish I (MS for HS credit) ONLINE	For course on NCVPS

*It is recommended that Middle School World Language courses for high school credit take place over at least three semesters. The options listed above provide choices for a variety of scheduling options. Note the course codes that do not carry a credit. Credit is granted once a student has meet curriculum requirements.

You have essentially the same two scheduling options with other languages. Use the chart below in order to build your schedule. Note that most languages other than Spanish can only be scheduled at a magnet school.
